A great week in Year 4!

This week, in Year 4 we have been reading Varjak Paw and using our reading skills to analyse the text to help us with our descriptive writing! We have also created some wonderful art inspired by the illustrations in the book.

In Religion, we have been learning about the importance of Jesus and how God gave us the gift of love and friendship in the form of Jesus Christ. We have written thank you letters to God, thanking him for all he has given us and for allowing us to live the lives that we are so grateful to have.

In Science this half term, we have been learning about the different states of matter. Year 4 have created some fantastic posters about the different states of matter and even completed an experiment comparing different materials!

In Geography, we discussed the different types of settlements and where we would like to live. We also discussed where our families are from. "I would like to live in a rural area because I like the greenery and it is a very quiet place to live. I also like the countryside as it is very beautiful and there are lots of animals there."



Busy Bees in Year 3

This week Year 3 explored reflection as part of our Science topic. We looked at lines of symmetry and used mirrors to reflect lines at an angle to make triangles.





In Religion, we have started our Advent unit of work, and have been thinking about visitors. We talked about visitors to our home and school, how we feel when we have visitors and how we prepare. As part of our preparation for Christmas, we then made our Advent pledges. We will be joining our holly leaves together to make a wreath for our display.



For the past month, we have been working hard in English, developing our writing skills. We looked at The True Story of the Three Little Pigs and got inspired by this twist on a traditional tale so we wrote some newspaper reports. We have learnt how to use direct speech and to include eye-witness accounts to add depth to our reports. What amazing writing!
