Our topic this half-term will be 'Night and Day'

<u>Date and Weekly Topics</u>	<u>Phonics</u>	<u>Additional Home Learning</u>
Week 1 – 02/11/20 Bonfire Night and Remembrance Day	Learn Sounds r, h. Recognise Phase 2 Tricky Words. Name writing. Writing simple CVC words.	RE - Talk about baptism and look at any pictures you may have from your own baptism. UtW - Hold a minute silence for remembrance day. Think about loved ones that are no longer with us. EAD – Can you create your own Bonfire Night picture? Use any resources you have – pencils, paints, glitter, cardboard boxes for rockets.
Week 2 – 09/11/20 Nocturnal Animals	Learn Sounds b, f. Recognise Phase 2 Tricky Words. Name writing. Writing simple CVC words.	Maths - Counting moving objects. Place a random amount of floating objects in a bowl of water or bath and try to count them as they move. Topic - Choose a nocturnal animal and try to learn 3 new facts about it. With help, use words and drawings to create your own fact book about this animal.
Week 3 – 16/11/20 Nocturnal Animals	Learn Sounds ff, l. Recognise Phase 2 Tricky Words. Name writing. Writing simple CVC words.	RE – Look at any photos taken on your birthday (please share any you have on Tapestry). Why do we celebrate birthdays? What is your favourite part of your birthday? Maths – Collect a small selection of random objects around your house! Talk about what makes these objects similar and different? (i.e., size, colour, shape, texture, weight)
Week 4 – 23/11/20 Shadows	Learn Sounds ll, ss. Recognise Phase 2 tricky words. Name writing. Writing simple CVC words.	Maths – Choose 3 of your favourite toys and compare their height. What can you use to measure the different heights? (e.g. tape measure, LEGO blocks). Record your findings! EAD – Using your fingers or favourite toys, can you create your own shadow puppet show? Can you retell parts of your favourite story in the shadow puppet show?
