Grid homework

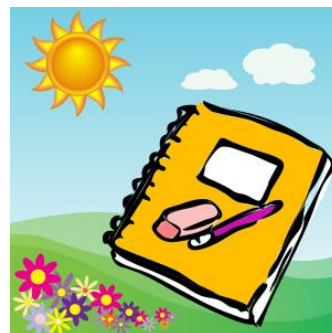
