

Year 6's Wonderful Work

Year 6 have been very busy over the last couple of weeks settling back into school life. They have the very important role of being the leaders in our school and we will soon be electing our House Captains that will represent our new House Saints. The children have written a few pieces about the work they have been studying recently.

In Year 6, we have been reading the book , 'The London Eye Mystery', by Siobhan Dowd. It is about a boy called Ted Spark, who solves the mystery of his missing cousin, Salim, with the help of his older sister Kat. We made silhouette pictures in art of the London cityscape inspired by the setting in the book. It is a fantastic book with a great plot and we are loving reading it!



In Science this week, we have been learning about electricity! We have learnt what components are represented by the different electrical symbols and how to draw circuit diagrams. Afterwards, we made our own circuits using different electrical components.

In Geography, we learnt about coasts in the UK. We looked at maps and labelled different coasts around Britain. The class talked about the different coastal towns we have visited. We then used a key to locate coastal resorts on the maps. In another lesson, we learnt how to use 4 and 6 figure grid references and we used ordnance survey maps to locate key points of interest.
