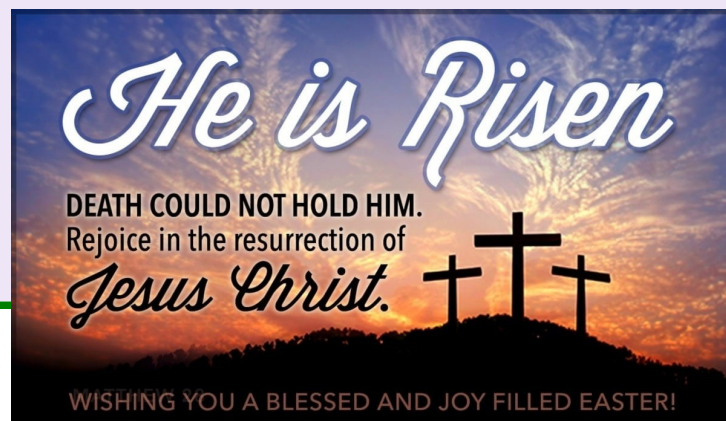

Easter Art Competition Winners

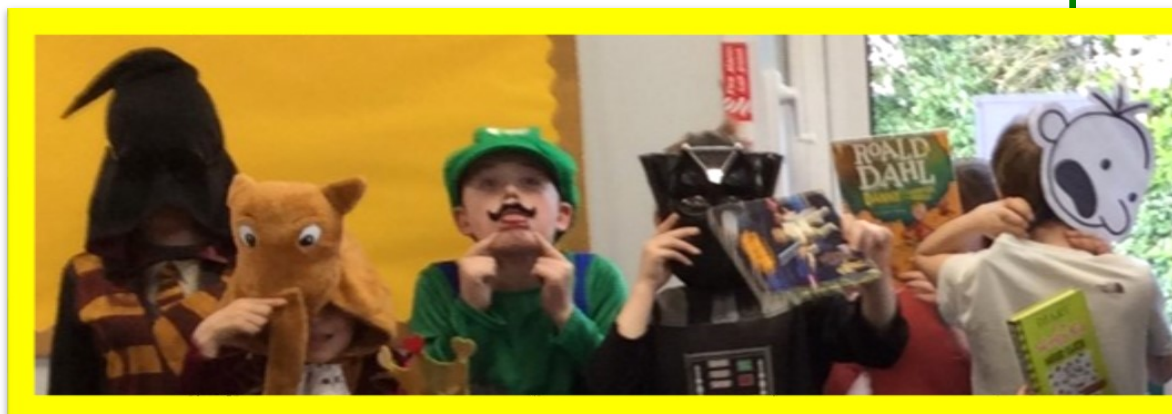

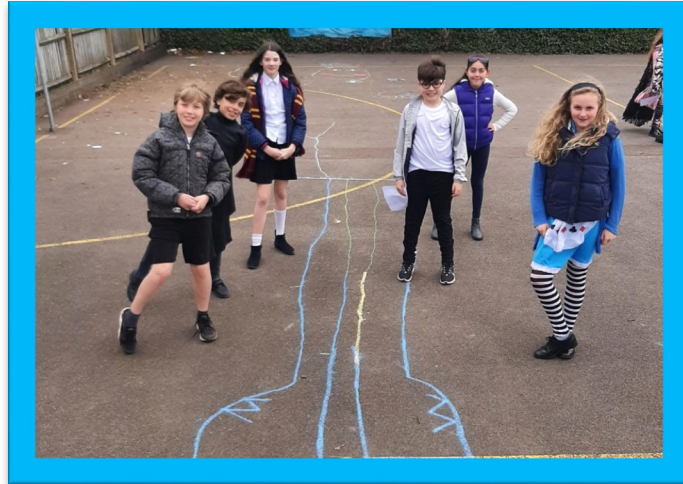


World Book Day Part 2!
