Make pictures for your loved ones



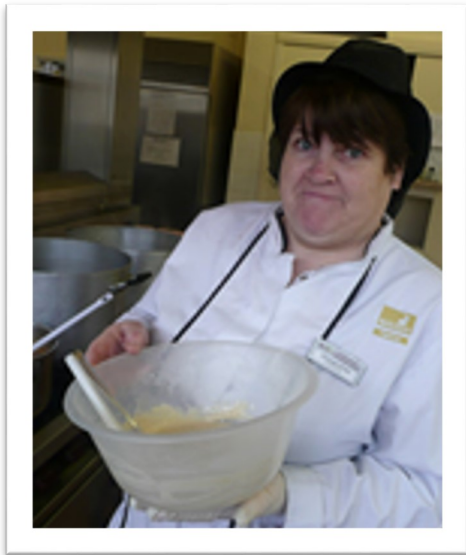
We make lots of things using different resources.
