### Grid Home Learning

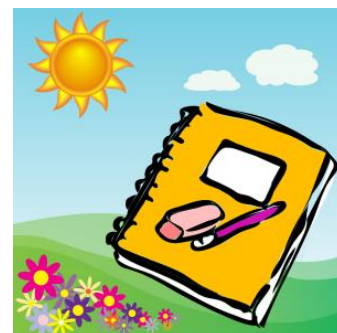

We look forward to seeing all your wonderful Home Learning this term. You could even gain up to 3 house points for impressive work!


