### **Gospel Assembly**

### The Secret of Black Rock in EYFS

EYFS have loved exploring the whole school text, *The Secret of Black Rock*, by Joe Todd-Stanton. This is an excellent story for the children's imagination and has a very important message about looking after our environment.

The Reception children firstly designed their own sea-creature and then thought about how their creature would move and whether it would be camouflaged or brightly coloured. The children wrote about or dictated their seacreature description, or wrote a story about Black Rock.

The Nursery children drew a picture of their interpretation of the story. They were inspired by the illustrations from the book and created their own unique, colourful drawings! The children recalled key events in the story and some even expanded their ideas into alternative endings.

This book-based project has incorporated knowledge of the natural world, creativity - using different media, as well as drama and singing– and has also developed some excellent literacy skills, encouraging children to use their phonic knowledge and imagination.






## At the Seaside ...
