Dear Parents and carers,

As you may recall from our last communication, the governors of St Alban & St Stephen Catholic Primary School & Nursery have taken the decision to initiate the consultation process regarding the acquisition of academy status and joining a Catholic Academy Trust with our partner Catholic schools in the Deanery.

This letter is informing you of the consultation, which opens on 28th April and closes on 23rd May 2025.

A consultation does not mean we have taken a final decision to convert to an Academy, but that we wish to seek the views of all our community to inform the final decision.
